

REACH Bulletin 19 Authorization Recommendations

Dear Customer,

ECHA have recommended that several substances be moved from the candidate list of substances of very high concern (SVHC) to the authorizations list in Annex XIV. This is the second list that ECHA have recommended to be subject to authorizations, the first list being in June 2009, the consolidated list of chemicals recommended for authorization is given below.
